The Project

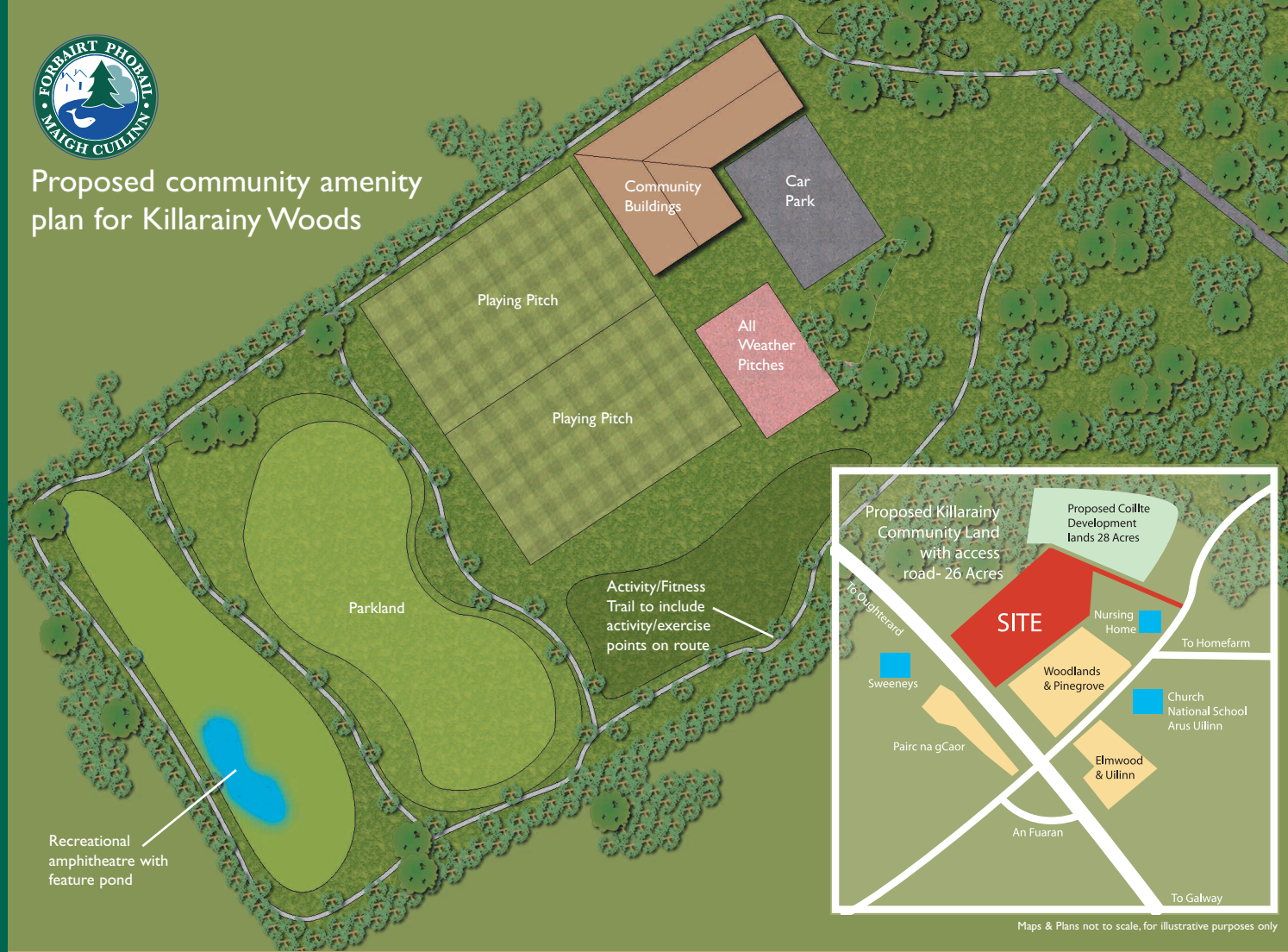
MCDA has been working on behalf of Moycullen Community to negotiate with Coillte a joint initiative for the development of Killarainey Woods. A major objective of the proposal was achieved recently with the re-zoning of the forest lands. Provided that planning permission can be obtained by Coillte for the development of low density housing and a small business park within 28 acres of the forest lands, the community will obtain the remaining 26 acres adjacent to the village (refer to map). MCDA will develop these lands for the benefit of the community, incorporating a modern multi-functional community centre alongside various community, sporting, and amenity facilities. It is envisaged that more than 40 local clubs and associations currently active in Moycullen will benefit directly from this project. It is imperative that the community, along with our local and national political representatives give full support to this MCDA-Coillte initiative. An Tionscnamh

Tá FPMC i mbun chainte le Coillte ar son phobal Mhaigh Cuilinn. Is é atá mar aidhm ag na cainteanna seo ná aontú shásúil a bhaint amach idir Coillte agus pobal Mhaigh Cuilinn maidir le forbairt na coille. B'ábhar sásaimh é le déanaí nuair a rinneadh Tailte na Coille a athzónáil. Má éiríonn le Coillte cead a fháil forbairt bheag tithíochta a thógáil, chomh maith le páirc ghnó, taobh istigh de na 28 n-acra atá sa choill, gheobhaidh pobal Mhaigh Cuilinn an 26 acra atá fágthá, taobh leis an mbaile (féach léarscáil). Forbróidh an FPMC na tailte seo ar mhaithe leis an bpobal. Curtha san áireamh san fhorbairt seo beidh ionad phobail, chomh maith le go leor áiseanna eile. Táthar ag súil go mbainfidh níos mó ná 40 club agus cumann áitiúil atá ag feidhmiú i Maigh Cuilinn faoi láthair taitneamh agus tairbhe as an dtionscnamh seo. Tá sé thar a bheith tábhachtach go dtabharfaidh an pobal, ár gcomhairleoirí áitiúla, agus ár dTeachtaí Dála tacaíocht iomlán don scéim seo idir Coillte agus FMPC. Eagrófar imeachtaí eolais amach anseo chun tuairisc a thabhairt ar an dul chun cinn atá déanta. Beidh fáilte roimh aon tuairimí nó smaointe atá ag daoine. Ná dean dearmad go bhfuil BHUR dtacaíocht riachtanach chun ár mbrionglóid a chur i gcrích.
